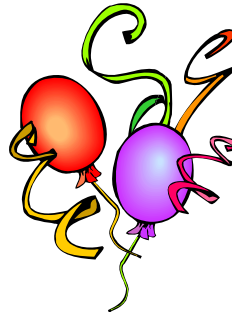

RUDY'S RECIPE CORNER

ITALIAN COOKIES

- 1/4 lb. butter
- 1/4 cup sugar
- 3 eggs
- 1 tsp vanilla
- 2 cups flour
- 2 tsp baking powder

In medium bowl cream butter and sugar until light and fluffy. Beat in eggs and vanilla. Combine flour and baking powder. Gradually add to creamed mixture and mix well. Drop by teaspoonfuls onto ungreased baking sheet.

Bake 350 for 9-11 minutes or until bottoms are lightly browned. Remove to rack and cool.

Icing

- 2 cups confect. sugar
- 3 tbsp. milk
- 1 tsp. vanilla

For icing - combine confect sugar, milk, and vanilla and mix until smooth. Ice cookies, top with coconut or chopped nuts if desired. Let stand until set. Makes about 40 cookies.

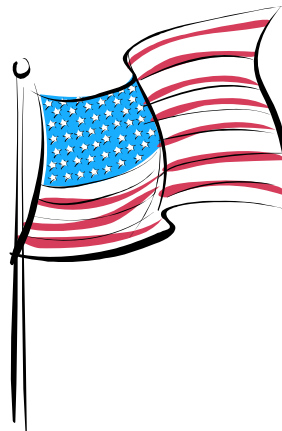
